Patient Encounter Flow From JVK-Meditech/Biotek

SioTek - PARTNERS

 Patient is seen for a typical office visit and presents with chronic environmental allergy symptoms

 Physician suspects allergy related cause, notes chronic history of allergy in chart, performs an ENT exam and requests an Allergy Test

 JVK-Meditech/BioTek employed Medical Assistant/LPN explains the test, obtains consent and performs an Allergy Skin Test in the BioTek/Meditech dedicated space in Physician's office

Patient Encounter Flow (Cont.)

- Test performed for the top 60 antigens (molds, pollens and dander)
- Results obtained within 15 to 20 minutes are recorded by JVK-Meditech/BioTek employee and delivered to Physician for interpretation
- Upon Physician determination that Immunotherapy is appropriate from patient history, test results and patient consent, JVK-Meditech/BioTek employee creates a customized serum under physician supervision





Patient Encounter Flow (Cont.)

- Treatment Delivery Model
 - Home-Based Immunotherapy
 - Initial Injection
 - In office with 30 minute observation
 - Ramp Up Dosing
 - Every 2 months in office under observation
 - Maintenance Dosing
 - Every other day at home
- JVK-Meditech/BioTek employee records changes in allergy symptoms at each follow up visit
- At the end of one year, Patient is retested to obtain objective desensitization results



Safety

- Eliminate contra-indicated patients
 - History of anaphylaxis
 - Severe asthmatics
 - Auto immune disorders
 - Beta blockers, pregnancy, etc
- EpiPen instruction and demonstration
- Gradual increases throughout the year
- Dosage strength increases in office

Benefits Across Entire Spectrum

- Additional Physician compensation for services performed




Payer Benefits

- Down line cost savings related to reduced ED visits, pharmaceuticals and labor related to injections
- Better delivery mechanism for the right patients means greater compliance leading to healthier patients
- Access to previously underserved populations to provide new and more effective treatment protocols



The Numbers

- The CDC states that over 1/3 of the U.S. population suffers from allergies or allergy related symptoms.
- Medicare and Medicaid put out a study identifying 1 out of 5 people in the U.S. have allergies that need treatment.
- Allergies are the 5th leading chronic disease and 3rd most common in children.







The Numbers (Cont.) with Just 4%

Average patients seen per month per physician	500
Patient population with allergies (a)	<u>4%</u>
Patients per month tested	20
Average net benefit to practice per patient	<u>\$600</u>
Additional net monthly earnings	<u>\$12,000</u>
Annual Benefit to Physician/Practice	\$144,000

(a) CMS Guideline for patients with allergies that need treatment is 17%.



The following is an estimate of an average single physician practice.



A Bit about JVK-Meditech/Biotek Lab

- 85% Conversion Rate
 - Patients tested that agree to treatment
- 70% Compliance
 - Complete at least one year of treatment
- 85% efficacy
 - Complete or substantial desensitization



Costs to the Practice

- JVK-Meditech/BioTek provides all equipment, supplies and medical personnel and installs lab with no initial up front expense to the Practice;
- \$950 to train designated MA/LPN for program certification
- Basic Equipment necessary for the program (fridge, blood draw chair, storage cabinet, computer with internet access)

The Practice provides:

- 100-150 sq.ft. of dedicated space (no carpet or wallpaper for OSHA compliance)
- Phone line & internet access
- Sharps biohazard disposable service
- Other than treating patients, that's it!



JVK-Meditech/BioTek also Provides

- All the ongoing materials and supplies needed to perform testing and create all treatment sets;
- Extensive training and Ongoing needed certification for MA/LPN;
- Continued training of staff regarding clinical process updates;
- Implementation team ensuring successful start-up;
- Continuing updates of required medical records to meet standards and ongoing MA/LPN oversight;
- Access to Medical Director for peer to peer discussion;
- Ongoing insurance verification services for allergy program;
- Review and response preparation for insurance issues;
- License to utilize JVK-Meditech/BioTek's proprietary processes for clinical and billing application.
